

## ALPHA SIGMA ALPHA INDIANAPOLIS, INDIANA



### DESCRIPTION

Completed in 2008, this 7,282 square foot national headquarters facility features a Georgian style architecture. Alpha Sigma Alpha, working with a budget of \$1 million, maximized the amount and quality of space by utilizing the design-build approach with the Browning-Cripe team.

Built on the northwest side of Indianapolis, in close proximity to other national Greek headquarters, the facility contains administrative offices, a board room and an archive museum.

### CHALLENGES

To construct an architecturally pleasing facility within a very limited Owner budget. Construction of the facility started in October and extended through the winter.
