

## UNIVERSITY HIGH SCHOOL CARMEL, INDIANA



### DESCRIPTION

This 45,000 square foot stand-alone building for a private high school in Carmel, Indiana, features 16 classrooms, a two-story atrium, student commons, and administrative offices. It is the second facility of several master-planned for the high school and compliment the existing athletic and performing arts facility.

An extremely tight budget and extraordinary weather conditions posed many challenges to this 10 month project.
